

Victim's Parents Tell Yonkers They Will Sue

The parents of Stacy Moskowitz, the last victim of the "Son of Sam" killer, plans to sue the city of Yonkers for \$10 million, charging that its Police Department failed to follow up complaints against David R. Berkowitz, accused of being the killer.

"Stacy Moskowitz would be alive today if the police had done an adequate and proper job in following up a major lead," said Spencer Lader, a lawyer representing the dead girl's parents, Jerome and Neysa Moskowitz who live in Brooklyn where the slaying occurred.

Mr. Lader said Sam Carr of Yonkers, a neighbor of Mr. Berkowitz, had complained to police three or four months ago that his dog had been shot and had told them a month and a half before the Moskowitz slaying that he suspected Mr. Berkowitz to be the so-called .44 killer.

"They should have made a proper investigation and didn't," he said. Mr. Lader said notice of the claim had been filed with the City of Yonkers and that he had a year and 90 days to file the suit.
