

4 Newsmen Arrested In Suspect's Apartment

Yonkers, Aug. 11—Four newsmen were arrested today after they allegedly were found inside the "Son of Sam" suspect's apartment after it was officially sealed by the police.

Those arrested were David Berliner and Robert Kalfus, both working on the story for the Washington Post; Ted Cowell, a freelance photographer working for Time magazine, and Lenny Dietrick, a staff photographer for the Daily News. They face arraignment on the charges tomorrow in Yonkers City Court. They will be charged with criminal trespass, a Class-A misdemeanor, and could be sentenced to a year in jail and fined up to \$1,000 each.

They were released on their own recognizance today after being booked, but the police seized and kept the film that was in the men's cameras.
